- ✓ **Partner across the enterprise.** Work with Legal, Risk, Information Security, Privacy, HR, and Data teams to embed compliance in AI initiatives.
- ✓ **Advise leadership and the Board.** Provide clear, risk-based guidance and reporting on AI compliance posture, incidents, and emerging risks.
- ✓ **Build a culture of integrity.** Promote speak-up culture, ethics training, and accountability at every level of the organization.
